In conjunction with the film we will be exhibiting portraits of older adult athletes from our local area who continue to be active as they age. **We ask you to submit the name of someone you know who has captured the spirit of active living.**

We are looking for your friends, neighbors, or patients that are participating in athletics at an older age. It could be someone with an inspirational story that has overcome adversity to be able to return to a sport after surgery, post stroke or trauma. Criteria for entry are:

- An older adult 75 years of age and older and currently living in the New York Metropolitan area
- Currently is active in an athletic sport or activity
- Would agree to be photographed and in press release

We will send a photographer to take a portrait while the athlete is engaged in their activity which could be, for example, swimming, exercising, biking, skiing, walking, running, or dancing.

We plan a screening of the film and a reception on Friday, April 27 at 2:00 pm. Each senior athlete chosen for the photographic portrait exhibition will be recognized at the event.
